Project Description: Mount Gilead Baptist Church is a religious campus consisting of four building facilities including an auditorium, family center, three-story education building, and administration offices.

Project Construction: Mount Gilead Baptist Church is constructed using conventional structural steel frames and lateral load resisting systems composed of vertically braced and rigid frames. Long clear span conditions are accomplished utilizing structural steel trusses and open web steel joists. The foundation system consists isolated and continuous footings, and the slab system consists of a reinforced concrete slab on a chemically stabilized subgrade.
